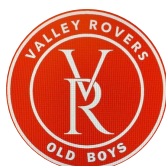

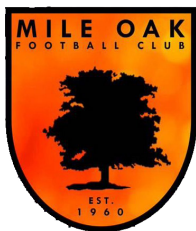

MILE OAK VETERANS

Formed: 2015

Bio: The vets were formed in 2015 by Tony Burnett to give a few aged players a chance to play on, the Club joined the Mid Sussex Fred Pretty Trophy.

2015/16 - In our 1st season we reached the final but lost on penalties to Hassocks Vets, whilst exiting the County Cup in the quarters to Eastbourne Town, losing 5-4.
2016/17 saw us win the Fred Pretty Trophy with a 4-2 win over rivals Hassocks, whilst exiting the County cup in the quarters again, to Eastbourne Town, this time 7-5.
2017/18 saw us lose 5-1 to Horley in the Trophy in the knockout semi final stage. But we lifted the County Cup with a 5-2 win over Haywards Heath, having beaten Eastbourne 7-6 in the quarters.

2021/22 was a strange season. Almost a double winning year that ended with us losing a title play off, hastily arranged due to an identical league record, on penalties following a 2-2 draw with our old nemesis, Horley! And guess what, we lost the County Cup Final at Lancing against Eastbourne Town, 2-0, following an early penalty & dubious red card for hand ball!!
2022/23 our 9th year saw us switch to the all conquering Sussex Sunday Vets league. 2 wins to begin the season was followed by back to back league defeats to bring us back down to earth. We ended up runners up by a single point behind white hart, but avenged that by knocking them out of the county cup & winning it for a 2nd time, beating pagham 4-0 in the final. However we lost to Steyning on penalties in the vets league cup final, following a 1-1 draw.
2023/24 was a fantastic but frustrating season, winning the vets Premier Ige title but frustratingly denied the chance to defend our county cup due to an admin error - but we did win the vets cup with a 4-0 victory over Worthing Town.

This is also the last season in charge for gaffer Tony Burnett, who is handing over the reigns after ten years.

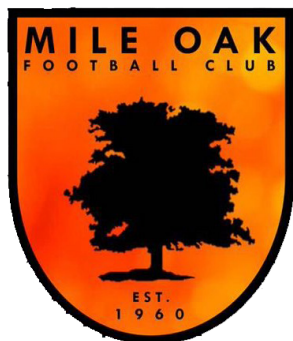
