May I take this opportunity to ask that if anyone is looking to get into over 35s or over 45 football please do not hesitate to contact anyone on the committee.

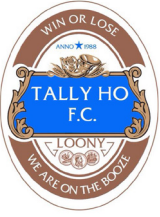
